Seneca College in partnership with the Ontario Ministry of the Environment has developed a training program for dry cleaners. Dry cleaning operators who complete this course will be in compliance with **Ontario Regulation 323/94 (Dry Cleaners) under the Environmental Protection Act** which requires at least one full-time person be trained in the management of contaminants and wastes in connection with the operation of dry cleaning equipment that uses certain solvents (perchloroethylene, methyl chloroform, or petroleum solvents).

Successful completion of this training is mandatory as is re-training every 5 years. Training is available in English, French and Korean.
